Notice of Petition to Amend the Certificate

Due to unforeseeable delays, the Petition described herein was not filed on or about April 7, 2025 as was stated in a prior notice. Accordingly, the notice is being repeated herein with a new filing date for the Petition.

Excelsior Energy Center, LLC (the “Certificate Holder”), a subsidiary of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC, received a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, with Conditions, (“Certificate”) for the Excelsior Energy Center (the “Project”) on April 6, 2022 (Case No. 19-F-0299). The Certificate authorizes the construction and operation of a 280-megawatt solar farm generating facility in the Town of Byron, Genesee County, New York. This Notice announces that on or about May 2, 2025, the Certificate Holder will file a Petition to Amend the Certificate pursuant to NYCRR § 1000.16 seeking a modification to the Certificate from the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (“Siting Board”). The proposed modification includes the addition of four new parcels to provide a route within private property for the installation of certain collection lines that reduce the need to run underground collection lines within Town- and State-owned public rights-of-way.
